


The Great Commission

You should be face to face with someone.



- A Document published in 1997 by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (Publication No. 5-004)
- In 1976 A Vision of Youth Ministry was published.
- Renewing the Vision builds on this and offers a blueprint for the continued development of ministry with youth.

Goals of Youth Ministry



Goal 1 Empowerment: To empower young people to live as disciples of Jesus Christ in our world today. (RTV 9)



Goal 2 Participation: To draw young people to responsible participation in the life, mission, and work of the Catholic faith community. (RTV 11)



Goal 3 Growth: To foster the total personal and spiritual growth of each young person.
(RTV 15)







Comprehensive Youth Ministry

- Youth Ministry vs. Youth Group
 - Groups assume we are all the same
 - Groups assume we're available at the same time
 - Groups assume that one or two adults can do it
 - -Groups assume you like groups

Eight Components

- Advocacy: integrated, mission, impact
- Catechesis: develop, increase, enrich, expand live
- Community Life: builds develops nurtures
- Evangelization: good news, invites, recognition, enables, openness
- Justice, peace and service: nurtures, empowers infuses
- Leadership Development/Enablement: calls forth, affirms, empowers
- Pastoral Care/Guidance: promoting, caring, providing guidance, challenging
- Prayer and Worship: celebrates, deepens, awakens, incorporates, nurtures, and fosters








Be Velcro

- Sticky faith is both internal and external
- Sticky faith is both personal and communal
- Sticky faith is both mature and maturing

Findings from Sticky Faith

- Build relationships with adults
- Help children find a church support system in college
- Focus on trusting in Jesus, and not the dos and don'ts



Catechists Role in Youth Ministry

- Transition Middle Schoolers into Confirmation
- Bridge the gap between "Youth Group vs. Confirmation." "Their teens and our teens".
- Evangelization of Youth Ministry in the Confirmation Program
- Catechist should journey with the teens in Youth Ministry becoming Velcro



Benefits of Youth Ministry to the Confirmation Program

- Teens have more support and more role models in their life.
- Leadership development can come out of Youth Ministry
- Leaders can become peer leaders for Middle school as well as Confirmation preparation
- Teens that may attend Youth Ministry nights/events can be inspired to join the Confirmation Program.
